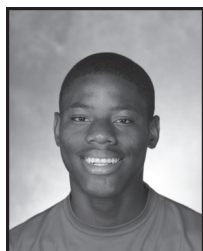

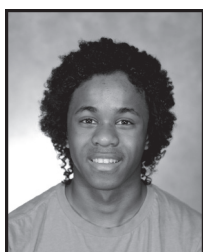


FELIX ANTWI-MENSAH

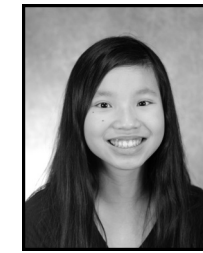

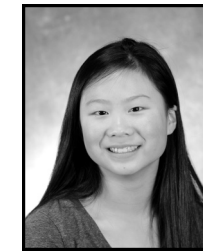
JOSHUA TRUE
